

RELEASE FINTAN LANE

Fintan Lane, a Cork anti-war campaigner, is locked up in Limerick Prison for 60 days for refusing to pay a €750 fine (the sentence runs from 26th November 2003 until 25th January 2004).

The fine was imposed after Fintan Lane took part in a mass trespass at Shannon Airport to protest against U.S. military use of the airport.

Fintan Lane will not pay the fine: "What we did was an act of conscience.

Shannon airport has been integrated into the U.S. war machine and the Irish government is complicit in the killing of many innocent civilians in Iraq and Afghanistan. This is not acceptable."
