THE majority of the Irish people do not want the US military using Shannon airport. But Bertie Ahern has given them re-fueling facilities.

He now has the blood of innocent Iraqi civilians on his hands.

Ahern says that a withdrawal of facilities would be a 'hostile act' and lead to a flight of US investment.

But other neutral countries such as Austria and Switzerland are not collaborating in Bush's war.
